- The Beach Boys were formed in California in 1961.
- The 5 original members consisted of brothers Brian, Carl and Dennis Wilson; their cousin Mike Love, and their friend Al Jardine.
- Brian Wilson (bottom right in picture) was the main songwriter.





The Music

- The Beach Boy's music was categorised as pop/rock or surf pop.
- The music was recognisable from its close vocal harmonies and it's upbeat and positive style.
- Their music (and particularly their album Pet Sounds) was a big influence on The Beatles and countless other bands.
